- o Ergonomics in information processes and organization management systems,
- Human factor in organizational systems of lean production,
- Human factor in organizing concepts on agility of enterprises,
- o Human factor and innovation and technological entrepreneurship of organizations,
- Man in pro-quality management of organizations,
- Development of human professional skills and employee training processes as key factor to competitiveness and business success of an organization,
- o Ergonomic awareness of employees and its shaping,
- o Safety culture in contemporary and future organizations,
- o Continuous improvement of work safety,
- o Ergonomic criteria in occupational risk assessment,

- o Dissemination of ergonomic standards of working conditions,
- Work of older, disabled or yet disadvantaged people in contemporary and future organizations.

The design of the submitted paper has to reveal a relationship between the aforementioned fields and the various methods of OR.
